All tuitions require an enrollment deposit of \$550.

\$500 of this deposit is a portion of the annual tuition and is deducted from the total tuition schedule once paid.

Additional Fees, Discounts, and Tuition Assistance

Children are enrolled for the full school year (September-June) and the family is responsible for the full tuition balance from the date of acceptance. Tuition for the full period of enrollment is not subject to adjustment because of illness, absence, withdrawal or dismissal from school.

APPLICATION AND ENROLLMENT FEES

A one-time, non-refundable application fee of \$150 is required for new students.

A tuition deposit of \$500 is required at the time of enrollment for all students. This deposit is a portion of the annual tuition and is deducted from the total tuition schedule once paid.

MATERIALS AND ACTIVITIES FEES

These fees cover such items as snacks, classroom supplies, field trips and travel expenses (for students of age). Fees vary depending on program selection. Like school tuition, Materials and Activities Fees are paid through FACTS Tuition Management and can be applied as a one-time fee or be rolled into the tuition schedule.

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE FEES

PCMS provides quality before and after class care for enrolled children. Before school care hours are 7:00-8:45 a.m. After school care hours are from 3:30-6:00 p.m. Like school tuition, before and after care fees are paid through FACTS Tuition Management and can be applied as a one-time fee or be rolled into the tuition schedule.

HOT LUNCH

Hot lunch is a business that our adolescent students manage. Families may choose to order if they desire. Fees for Hot Lunch vary depending on your order choices. Hot Lunch orders may be purchased for an additional fee.

AFTER SCHOOL CLASSES

Throughout the school year, after school classes will become available for the children. After school class fees vary depending on the offerings. After school classes can be purchased for an additional fee.

ADDITIONAL FEES

Facts Tuition Management Fees: Facts fees vary. Your Facts account will share details.

Late Payments: A \$30 per month charge will be added to tuition that is unpaid ten days after the due date.

NSF Checks: A fee of \$30 will be charged for each check that is returned by the bank as NSF or otherwise not collectible.

LATE PICKUP: A \$5 per minute late fee applies after the selected tuition option. These charges are billed separately and paid to the school, but go in their entirety to the caregivers who stay late.

TUITION DISCOUNTS

Sibling Discount

Second children from the same family receive a 10% discount on tuition. This applies only to two children enrolled in full-day programs at any combination of age levels. The discount will be taken from the lowest payment option selected. Please inquire about rates for larger families.

Alumni Discount

The best compliment we can receive is that of our graduates returning to enroll their children! Parents who attended our program and graduated from our Middle School, are entitled to an Alumni Discount. Our Alumni families receive a 10% discount on tuition.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Every year, we meet families who would like to send their children to our school who cannot afford the full cost of tuition.

We ask each family to focus on whether we are genuinely the right match for their family's values and their children's needs, interests, abilities, and learning approach. Finding families who are the right "fit" takes effort and is our priority. We are

looking to forge a long-term partnership relationship based on mutual values and beliefs about what constitutes a great educational experience.

As an independent, non-profit school, we depend entirely on tuition and limited resources for our annual operating budget. However, we have built an allowance for tuition assistance into our budget. Our funds are limited; however, we do our best to find ways to support families. We invite families needing tuition assistance to apply through a third-party reviewer who gives the tuition assistance committee the documentation required to make informed decisions. The third-party organization, Fast Financial Aid, helps help us accurately and fairly assess a family's ability to pay and, after review, award grants accordingly.

As funds are available, our school offers need-based assistance to make tuition affordable for more families.

Tuition assistance applications are available through our [FAST financial aid program](#) located on our website under Admissions. Deadlines for tuition assistance applications are due March 1.

UNFORSEEABLE EVENTS

The school shall not be liable for any failure or delay in the performance of its duties or obligations to the extent such failure or delay is caused by a force majeure or an event beyond the school's reasonable control. This includes, but is not limited to, a fire, flood, act of God, war, government action, act of terrorism, epidemic, pandemic, natural disaster or other major upheaval which renders performance impractical, illegal, impossible or otherwise inadvisable. In such an event, the school's duties and obligations shall be suspended until such time as the school, in its sole discretion, determines that it may safely and ably resume performance.

The school shall provide notification of such a suspension by a reasonable time and method. During such a suspension, parents shall make all payments due to the school and there will be no refund of tuition, fees, or other payments previously made. As an alternative to suspending performance, the school may elect to operate on a distance-learning basis, may choose to extend or shorten its school year, and may adopt an alternative schedule to complete its school year curriculum.
